lunch.


REGISTRATION: Registration can be done by using the Link on

"TEN COMMANDMENTS HIKE"

Saturday, October 24th, 2020 at Chillicothe

Sponsored by the Relationships Committee of the Pony Express Council Committee. John Parks of Pack 121 of Chillicothe is this year's coordinator.

This "10 Commandment Hike" is a symbolic event to help enrich our scouts in understanding the importance of reverence, Honor to God, and respect for the beliefs of others.

Our Ten Commandment Hike will be about 2-3 miles long and will visit several churches. At each stop, a member of the clergy or their representative will give a brief introduction to their church and speak on one or two of the commandments.

Our **Chillicothe Hike** will begin at 9:30 in Chillicothe at the Calvary Baptist Church 206 Locust Street. This is North of 36 Highway right on 65 Highway at 3rd street and 65 Highway. The parking lot is just south of the Church on the right side of the street.

Most all streets have sidewalks and crossing guards will be used at all street crossings. Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and leaders will meet at 9:30 a.m. for registration and organization for the Hike. After registration, the groups will meet for the opening Ceremony and the explanation of the first two Commandments. From there the group will hike to the next church for an explanation of the 3rd and 4th Commandments. Scouts will hear an explanation of the 5th and 6th Commandments and eat lunch at the third church. Following lunch, the group will be given a presentation on the Religious Emblems Program. From there the group will hike to the last two churches and hear an explanation of the last four Commandments. The event should be over by about 2:00 p.m.

This hike is a "rain or shine" event. All participants should bring water, a sack lunch and rain gear and coats or jackets as necessary. **This event can be used to complete or partially complete requirements including Cub Wolf: #10a, 11b, 11c, Cub Bear #10a, 12b, d, e, and #18f, g, Webelos #8 c partial for Arrow of Light.**

Each participating unit is to fill out a registration form. Additional registration forms are available at the Council Service Center, and at District Roundtables.

Each will receive a "10 Commandment Hike" patch.

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Protestant (To be used for the 2020 Hike)

1. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
2. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.
3. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
5. Honor thy father and thy mother; that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
6. Thou shalt not kill.
7. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
8. Thou shalt not steal.
9. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
10. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbor's

Catholic

1. I am the Lord thy God. Thou shalt not have strange gods before me.
2. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.
3. Remember thou keep the Sabbath Day.
4. Honor thy Father and thy Mother.
5. Thou shalt not kill.
6. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
7. Thou shalt not steal.
8. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
9. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife.
10. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's goods.

Hebrew

8. Thou shall not steal.
9. Thou shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
10. Thou shall not covet your neighbor's house, his wife, his servants, his animals, or anything of your neighbor's.
