

NYLT 2022 Q&A

- **Location** Camp Geiger - Strong Bull with shelter, shower & bathrooms available. Other areas of Camp Geiger will be used as needed for course. (All showers and bathroom stalls have doors with locks.)
- **Sleeping Arrangements** 2 to a tent (Camp Geiger Tents) during the week following YPT guidelines; Each Scout will be in their own tent during Friday night outpost;
- **Meals** Meals will be at our Dining Site location. (Outside of Camp Geiger Dining Hall just to the southwest) Feast will be held on Saturday at 5pm prior to graduation. Parents/Guardians please join!
- **Presentations** Presentations will be held downstairs within Herzog Lodge.
- **Packing List** 5 nights/6 days with 6x10 tarp with 8 stakes, piece of string with a 2 man tent, a cot and a foldable chair. Please bring their own water bottle. (A cup will also be provided.)
- **Mess Kit** Plate, bowl, silverware, mesh bag with drawstring (Cup will be provided) (Water bottle encouraged to bring)
- **Start time on Monday**
• **Graduation time on Saturday** 1st day on Monday begin arriving between Noon and 1pm to check-in. Stop at check-in cabin and then proceed to Herzog lodge, stopping at each station. **Follow those directing you.** Last day on Saturday @ 5pm will be our Feast with graduation to follow at 6pm @ South Campfire Council ring - Parents are encouraged to come to the graduation and then will take their scout home after that.
- **Camp Geiger entrance requirements**

- **Expectations for the week for NYLT Course** **Participants are here for NYLT** and will not participate in any Camp Geiger activities including Trading post and Mic-O-Say.
Class A uniforms will be needed, (Scout shirt, Scout shorts/pants, Scout socks and Scout belts) (Please no sashes or neckerchief)
Class B uniforms are being provided (total of 2)
- **Wireless devices** Phone devices should not be utilized unless for an emergency and are discouraged from being brought.
- **Jewelry/Valuables** Anything of importance or that is a keepsake is at risk of being lost/stolen while at camp. It is highly encouraged to leave behind sentimental jewelry and such.
- **Friday night outpost** Supervision with a minimum of 2 deep leadership will be maintained overseeing the area for outpost
