2021 National Jamboree: Face the Challenge

Register as a Council Contingent youth participant starting in December 2019

Overview and Organization:

The BSA National Jamboree is a once in a lifetime opportunity for most Scouts. It is the highlight of any Scouts experience by being involved with the best Scouting has to offer as far as outdoor program. Scouts from all over the United States will gather, more than 35,000 for the promise of high adventure, friendship and fellowship. The National Jamboree is on a first-come basis to everyone who qualifies. Participants will be assigned to a jamboree unit consisting of 40 participants (including youth and adults). Youth participants will be a member of a patrol within the unit. The Pony Express Council contingent/unit will consist of 40 total participants. Our contingent/unit will consist of 26 boy youth accompanied by 4 adults and 8 girl youth accompanied by 2 adults of which one adult will be an adult female.

Who: Any registered member of the BSA who is 12 years old by the first day of the jamboree (7/21/2021) and not yet 18 years of age, and completed and submits all forms and registration fees

Travel Plans: DRAFT subject to being altered

The Pony Express Council Contingent will leave from Camp Geiger approximately two days prior to the start of the Jamboree via a motor coach bus traveling to and from the jamboree including any side trips our tours. The contingent will spend the night in roofed lodging for the nights traveling.

The Pony Express Council Contingent will arrive at the Summit on July 21, 2021 and camp there through the morning of July 30. Scouts will camp in tents while at the Jamboree (July 21 to July 30 is the actual jamboree-these dates are not subject to change) The Pony Express Council Contingent will depart the Summit on July 30, 2021 and head back to St. Joseph with an arrival at Camp Geiger on Saturday, July 31, 2021.

Fee Includes:

The Jamboree fee covers all transportation, tours, admission fees, meals, lodging, contingent troop equipment, contingent polo shirt, patches. Consideration or any additional personal spending money would need to be arranged outside of the general fee cost of the trip.

Total Cost: \$2,250 per youth

Payment Schedule:

Deposit: \$250 per youth and \$250 per adult due; payable to Pony Express Council BY JANUARY 15, 2020

Second Payment: \$700 per youth and \$700 per adult due; payable to Pony Express Council BY JULY 15, 2020

Third Payment: \$700 per youth and \$700 per adult due; payable to Pony Express Council BY JANUARY 15, 2021

Final Payment: \$600 per youth and \$600 per adult due; payable to Pony express Council BY MAY 15, 2021
